B6521 Main Road Grindleford between junction of Mount Pleasant and junction with B6001 is closed to 7.5 Tonnes

REASON: To facilitate STW Mains Renewals.

Sir William Hill Road Junction: West and South: Edge Road, Hawkhill Road, Main Road Eyam, Church Street Eyam, The Dale Eyam, A623 Stoney Middleton, A625 Grindleford Road, B6001 Grindleford Road Calver

Access will be maintained, whenever reasonably possible, on the affected length of road. The road will re-open as soon as the work is finished. This may be earlier than advertised.
